


Writing as a Spiritual Practice is a five-session virtual workshop that invites you to explore the sacred dimension of your writing life. Whether you're journaling for personal growth, crafting business content with heart, or preparing your next book, this course helps you tap into your

inner wisdom and express your authentic voice.



Grounded in the Edgewalker framework, the course integrates five essential spiritual qualities (Self-Awareness, Passion, Integrity, Vision, Playfulness) and five dynamic skills (Knowing the Future, Risk-Taking, Manifesting, Focusing, Connecting) to help you write with depth, clarity, and soul. This intimate experience is limited to ten participants.

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- 5 live 90-minute Zoom sessions (every other week)
- One private coaching session with Judi Neal
- Writing buddy partnership for inspiration and accountability
- Audio/video recordings and AI-generated summaries
- A personal writing project with feedback and support

COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:

Each session creates sacred space and includes check-ins, thematic teachings, writing practices, and group support for writing projects. Sessions explore themes such as:

- Writing from the inner landscape
- Devotion and discipline in your writing life
- Authentic voice and spiritual integrity
- Visionary writing and sensing the future
- Joyful habits and celebrating your unique voice

Judi's workshops are known for a certain kind of magical connection that gets created within the group that supports new creative insights and growth.

Skill: *Knowing the Future*

Theme: Writing from the Inner Landscape

- Writing as a mirror for self-reflection
- Setting spiritual intentions for your writing
- Intuition, dreams, and channeling as creative tools
- Free-writing: "What is seeking to emerge?"
- Discussion: How do you know what wants to be written?
- Buddy introduction & alignment



Skill: Risk-Taking

Theme: Devotion and Discipline in Your Writing Life

- Tapping into your inner fire and purpose
- Taking risks with style, genre, and audience
- Overcoming resistance and perfectionism
- Guided writing: "The most passionate moment of my life"
- Creating rituals that support sustained creative energy
- Case discussion



Skill: *Manifesting*

Theme: Authentic Voice and Ethical Expression

- Writing in alignment with your deepest values
- Bringing your spiritual voice into professional writing
- Manifesting your vision through clear structure
- Artificial Intelligence as a partner
- Exercise: Craft a personal values statement for your writing
- Project planning: Timeline and tangible goals
- Feedback on authenticity and alignment
- Case discussion

Session 4: Vision

Skill: *Focusing*

Theme: Seeing Beyond and Writing the Future

- Writing for change, prophecy, or visionary leadership
- Spiritual guidance and long-term intention
- Tools for deep focus and flow
- Exercise: Write a vision statement for your writing project
- Case discussion



Skill: Connecting

Theme: Creativity, Joy, and Celebration

- Playful approaches to genre and process
- Appreciating your own and others' voices
- Joyful and sustainable writing habits
- Appreciation ritual
- Final sharing and next steps (publishing, blogging, continuing support)

Writing Buddy Guidelines

- Meet between each session for at least 45 minutes
- Share your progress and process (not critique)
- Reflect on what is flowing and where you feel blocked
- Hold space with kindness, curiosity, and non-judgment
