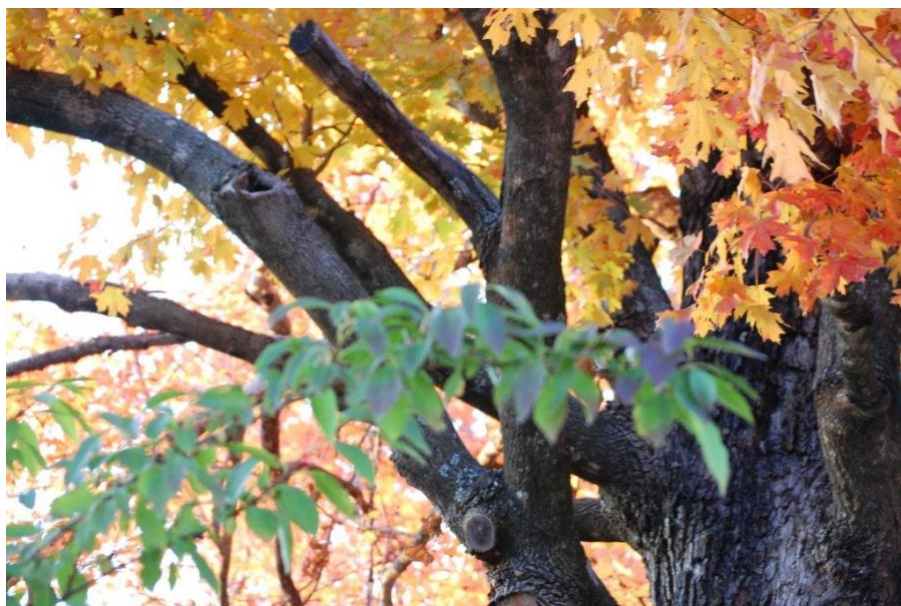




2025 Edgewalker Retreat – October 24–26 Fayetteville, Arkansas | Autumn in the Ozarks

The location will depend upon the number of registrations. If we have up to 15 registrations, we will hold the retreat at my house. It is relaxed and informal, with several rooms for breakout sessions and a rain garden and outdoor deck for energy and renewal.
